We know how to respond – Jesus showed us how. He spent time with broken people, he shared life with them, he talked with them, showed them compassion and offered them healing. We the church, can and should do the same. We welcome broken people, we spend time with them, we share life with them, we show compassion and we introduce them to Jesus who brings healing and hope to their brokenness.

What a great privilege and responsibility we have as the church to be a community where the broken find healing and restoration.


